RESUME STRATEGY

Nadia had built up a successful track record in public healthcare in the US and in 2018 returned to her home country to move into the realm of consulting. Her main targets for networking and pitching her services were international development organizations. However, she was finding it difficult to break into this rather crowded arena.

To showcase Nadia's health transformation and leadership abilities and position her for consulting roles, I have deliberately dedicated the whole first page of her resume to her assets, achievements and her consulting profile. Throughout the resume I have used language commonly used in international development, such as "healthcare access", "health outcomes", "capacity development" and "fragile environment".

I opted for the blue colour because many development organizations, e.g. UNICEF, UNHCR, the World Bank, will find it familiar. And I have used bold to consistently highlight achievements and value-added offerings for consultancies.

While Nadia is more familiar with US English, a hybrid mix of UN/UK English tends to be used in East Africa, which is her geographical focus. For this resume, spelling is in UK/Oxford English, but I have deliberately not used the Oxford comma.
